

### About the University

Khawaja Moinuddin Chishti Urdu, Arabi-Farsi University was established on October 01, 2009 under U.P State Universities (Amendment) Act. The objective of its establishment was to promote learning of Urdu, Arabic and Persian Languages and their culture. The University is presently located on 28 acres of land on Sitapur-Hardoi Bypass road, adjacent to Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Lucknow and the Government has also allocated 12 acres additional area to the University. The first academic session started in the year 2013 with the Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Commerce. The University offers undergraduate and post graduate courses with the subjects- Urdu, Arabic, Persian, English, Hindi, Journalism and Mass Communication, Geography, Home Science, Education, Computer Application, Physical Education, History, Political Science, Economics, Commerce and Business Administration.
